RIGHT: CORRECT. HONORABLE. JUST. "The reciprocity of right relationships needs go no further than the mutual and effective commitments of both (all) members to one another."

Relationship: the way(s) in which people, objects, or concepts are connected.

"The rightness of a relationship can be measured. ultimately. only by whether it is felt to be right by those concerned."
